SPAIN, Italy, Greece, the US and the Caribbean are the top choices for British holiddymakers this summer.

Portugal and France are also seeing a bookings bounce-back post-pandemic and are just behind 2019 levels. Not surprisingly, Qatar is proving popular, thanks to the World Cup in November, and Egypt's Red Sea resorts are gaining popularity.

The data from travel research firm Forward Keys revealed at the World Travel and Tourism Council summit shows travellers from the UK, Germany and France are driving the recovery—while there has also been a 350 per cent surge in travellers coming to Europe this year in compared to pre-pandemic, and bookings could fall again as the cost-of-living crisis at home and abroad hits.

And it seems the UK has fallen out of favour with international visitors and does not even make it into the top 20 worldwide destinations for travellers this summer.

Olivier Ponti, of Forward Keys, said: "The recovery in the UK has been a long process." Changes to restrictions and testing hampered it but now the UK is more consistent in its approach." And he did reveal that demand for city breaks in the UK is growing.
