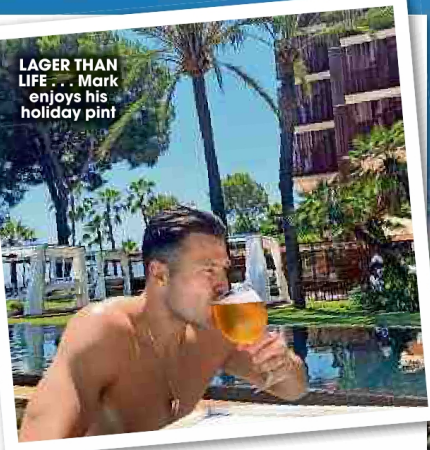

NORWAY IS BACK IN PLAY

news NORWAY is once again open for holidays. The country's latest travel rules, which came into play on

Wednesday, mean anyone crossing the border will no longer have to quarantine upon their arrival.

All travellers must complete an entry form 72 hours before travel and must take a free test on arrival at the airport – or within 24 hours if they cross the border at a point without test stations.

Anyone who is not vaccinated will also have to take a pre-departure test within 24 hours of leaving.

Children are not required to take a pre-departure test but still need to take one on arrival.

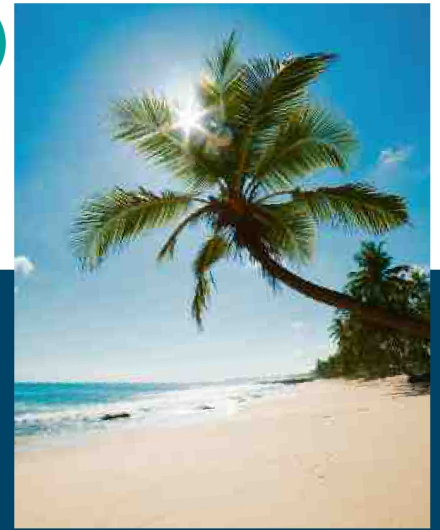
